Five Carpet Cleaning Tips

Here are five (5) carpet cleaning tips to help you maintain and care for your carpet.

1. Carpet Cleaning Tips - Create a carpet cleaning schedule.

Your carpet cleaning schedule should include, how often you intend to vacuum, what is your carpet cleaning system and when and who will implement your system.

Dust accumulation is your carpet's enemy. Regular vacuuming will reduce the dust level in your carpet.

Two of the most popular carpet cleaning systems are steam cleaning (hot water extraction), and dry carpet cleaning. The use of either of these methods when done properly will remove oils, greases and whatever stains that finds itself on your carpet.

2. Clean spills immediately.

It is a fact. The longer spills remain on your carpet the harder it is to clean them. Deal with them as soon as possible before you're faced with irremovable stains.

3. Use doorway mats.

Using mats at entrances to carpeted rooms will help reduce the amount of dust that would have ended up on your carpet. NOTE: You need to keep these rugs vacuumed.

4. Carpet Cleaning Tips - Your carpet cleaning supplies.

Carpet cleaners can be mild or very strong. Most contain chemicals which are highly dangerous like, hydrofluoric acid, tetrachloroethylene and butoxyethanol.

When using these products please read the manufactures instructions carefully and take the necessary precautions like wearing gloves and using goggles.

5. Hire a carpet cleaning professional

This is my most favorite thing to do. Let someone else worry about it.

When choosing a carpet cleaning professional be sure you ask for references. Your carpet is an investment; you shouldn't trust it with just anyone.

To bring back the joy of buying a new carpet we often use home steam carpet cleaners for the fresh clean smell.

Since carpets attract dirt from the air, even if there are no visible stains, at some point it needs to be cleaned.

Using steam cleaners or dry carpet cleaning systems are the usual choices. It is up to you to decide which carpet cleaning system is right for you and your carpet.

One would think that steam cleaning is better since the hotter the water the better the soot and dirt breaks up. Retracting or pulling out the water and dirt from the carpet removes most of the cleaning solution from your carpet.

If there are pets in the home, the best cleaners are the ones particular made to grab and pick up the fur of domestic animals like cats and dogs.

There are many different levels of steam cleaners. The prices vary from \$150.00 to over \$300.00.

If you want your carpets to be very deep cleaned, the more brushes and heat activators the unit allows the more effective it will be.

Many people want to steam clean their carpet fairly regularly just to feel the dirt and allergens are being removed. If you are one of them, then the average priced

steam carpet cleaners would be sufficient.

Carpet Cleaning Services

With all the carpet cleaning services being advertised through Valupak coupons, which carpet cleaning service is the best for your carpets?

When it is time to have the carpets cleaned, where do you turn?

Some of the choices you have to clean your carpets are to rent a machine and do it yourself; spend the money on buying your own carpet cleaning machine and tackle the job, then finding the room to store it.

After thinking about these choices, many people choose a carpet cleaning service. Are you one of them?

Choosing a Carpet Cleaning Service

The carpet cleaning service a person chooses now becomes the big decision. Do you choose a private company where all they do is carpet cleaning?

Or is your choice a department store like Sears that advertises carpet cleaning services?

Maybe you would prefer a carpet cleaning service recommendation from a friend. This is usually the best option because at least you know they were happy with the results and wouldn't recommend the carpet cleaning service if they were disappointed.

The other decision that needs to be decided when choosing a carpet cleaning service is the type of chemicals and process being used.

The choices are a dry solution, a steam extraction or some carpet cleaning services advertise a double process.

You must keep in mind that a carpet cleaning service also offers other products to add to the service contract, for example, sanitizing, a coating to detract dirt, or a pre stain removal.

These additions usually bring the carpet cleaning cost up. It is always important to ask the carpet cleaning service for the complete price with a written estimate before starting so there are no surprises.

Carpet Cleaning Machines

In order for a carpet cleaning machine to work properly, you would need to use some type of unit or piece of equipment to get all the dirt and allergens out from their carpet.

A carpet cleaning machine needs a type of carpet cleaning solution and hot water if the unit does not have a steamer attachment. The carpet cleaning supplies can be bought at Kohl's or Kmart, usually where vacuum cleaners are sold.

The machines can be very simple or the machine can have several added features. Some of the features in carpet cleaning machines would be a steamer feature, spin brushes and additional suction brushes. The solution is sold with the machine but usually you need to buy more if you are planning to clean more than one room.

There are several vacuum companies which sell carpet cleaning equipment also. The equipment is a bit more complex than a vacuum cleaner but the results are worth it when the carpets are cleaned from the soil or dirt which can be embedded in the carpet.

The biggest obstacle in the carpet cleaning machines is the container that has to be filled by mixing the warm water and the cleaning solution. Filling the containers are done in your sink, bathtub, or basin and then locks into the machine so the solution get sprayed on the carpet.

When retracting, the water, solution, and dirt are dispensed into the second container what stays empty awaiting the remains. When the second container is full the machine usually stops retracting the dirty water. You must then take the container with the dirty water and empty it into the toilet.

These steps are repeated when using the carpet cleaning machines every time fresh water and solution is used.

There is a range of carpet cleaning equipment for you to choose use. From carpet vacuum cleaners to carpet extractors (these are usually used by carpet cleaning professionals).

Of course the carpet cleaning equipment you purchase or rent depends on how much carpet cleaning you do on your own. If you simply wish to reduce the accumulation of dust on your carpet on a regular basis and leave the deep carpet cleaning to the professionals, then you can simply choose from the following carpet cleaning equipment.

Carpet Tips: Make Your Carpet Last Longer

1. Rearrange Your Furniture

It is good to move your furniture from time to time to change the traffic pattern in your house. Your carpet is worn down faster where people walk.

2. Vacuum Regularly

Dirt helps wear down the fibers in your carpet. Vacuum regularly and place a welcome mat at your home's entrances. Also consider a "no shoes" policy. High traffic areas can often use vacuuming once a day while low traffic areas can be vacuumed a couple of times a week.

3. Area Rugs

Depending on how your house is laid out you may have some areas that will have high traffic regardless of how your furniture is arranged. Consider area rugs in these locations.

4. Don't Let Dirt In

Keep the walk ways leading to your house clean. This will cut down on the amount of dirt that is tracked into your house.

5. Shampoo Rugs

Shampoo rugs at least once a year. Consult your manufacturer's specifications for what type of cleaning equipment and/or detergents are appropriate for your type of carpet.

6. Spill Awareness

Treat spills quickly for the best chance of avoiding a stain. If you have kids, make sure they know that they need to tell you about spills immediately so they do not have time to set.

7. Snip Loose Threads

To remove a loose thread that sticks up above the fiber use scissors to snip it instead of pulling on it which can pull out more than just the thread.

8. Designate Eating Areas

Many spills can introduce oils into your carpet which attract dirt and help lead to a dingy looking carpet. The less you eat in carpeted areas the better your chances are of avoiding these types of spills.

The cleaner you can keep your carpet the longer it will last. Hopefully these tips help you get more life out of your carpet.
